Second Sunday (Week 2) of Advent: The Peace and the preparations.

On the second week of Advent, we light the **Peace Candle** also known as the **Bethlehem Candle**. This candle symbolizes the peace that Jesus brings into our hearts and to the world. It reminds us of the Angels' declaration of peace on earth, the humble circumstances of his birth in Bethlehem and the preparations made by God for his arrival with the coming of John the Baptist.

Some bible verses for this week: **Proverbs 3:5 Isaiah 9: 6 – 7**

Luke 2: 14 John 14: 27



The peace that God brings through Jesus allows us to look at others through heaven's eyes and helps us to guide the world to see that God is here. Peace from God, biblical peace, allows us to trust in his promises made through Jesus in restful faith, despite the world around us. Through Jesus we receive God's inner peace and because of his work on the cross, we have a chance to receive salvation and be indwelled by the Holy Spirit. Not only do we have the peace that comes from assurance of our salvation, but also the peace of mind knowing God will heal this broken world and will come again.
