

Lent is fast approaching and as well as our Lent course to help us through Lent this year (see below) we are also very pleased to welcome Bishop Sam to lead and officiate for us at our 10.00am morning Holy Communion Ash Wednesday Service on the 18th of February.


Bishop Sam kindly supported our services last year and we are blessed that he can come and lead our 10.00am Ash Wednesday service which will have four hymns and, in many ways, be similar to our usual Sunday service.

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent, a 40-Day period of reflection and preparation for Holy Week and Easter, the day itself is characterized by a solemn reminder of human mortality and the need for repentance, as we reflect on our lives and seek to grow closer to God.

It will be a unique occasion at St Mary's to have a Bishop presiding over our Ash Wednesday service, and we hope that as many people as possible will come to church to welcome and support him.

Lent Course 2026 – Draw Near – Life giving habits for Lent

This year's Lent course is from the Church of England and is called 'Draw Near' life giving Habits for Lent. We will be meeting in the Fellowship Room on **Monday afternoons at 2pm** from the first Monday in Lent for anyone who wishes to join us. Everyone is welcome to join us for any week or all the Lent Course, please come along when you can.



We have a small booklet with daily readings and thoughts for you to use at home and this will form the springboard for our weekly get togethers.

We'll meet in the Fellowship Room at 2.00pm -3.30pm for a relaxed time of discussion and reflection, with the famous St Mary's refreshments.

Join us on **Mondays 23rd February, 2nd, 9th, 16th, 23rd and 30th March**. Please see Derek Buckthorpe or Ian Bunday for a booklet and to express an interest.

'Draw Near' offers us the opportunity to strengthen our habits and patterns which help us grow as disciples of Christ day by day, especially as we prepare to celebrate the great mystery of God's saving love at Easter.

Each week a different contributor explores a different aspect of Christian discipleship - **worshipping together, praying, exploring the Bible, sharing communion, offering service and sharing the good news** with others. There is also a special version for children.

The course has a supporting book 'Dancing to the Heartbeat of God' which includes a foreword and afterword by the Archbishop of Canterbury-designate, Dame Sarah Mullaly, and an introduction by the Archbishop of York, Stephen Cottrell. It offers a confident and hopeful vision of faith lived out in everyday life.

You can also sign up to the Everyday Faith App which will carry reflections based on the booklet.

While some of you will already have picked up the news, we wanted to be sure you were all aware that the Bishops have agreed to our going ahead to recruit a new Rector subject to our satisfying the Archdeacon that our ability to pay the full parish share within 3 years is realistic. You may have seen the handout which the Rural Dean provided when he preached on Thanksgiving Sunday (and which we are sending round with this weekly sheet) it shows that with careful management, David thinks we can balance the books this year, but we are paying just 80% of our parish share, so there is a little way to go.

We know you will all think prayerfully about giving and we are hugely grateful for all gifts of time talent and money as we move forward. Your generosity in raising more than £500 in Epiphany gifts has made an excellent start to 2026. Thank you.


